### Theme for this month: Getting to Know the Nursery

### Téama na míosa seo: Ag Cur Aithne ar an Náiscoil

Níl i gceist ach chun aithne a chur ar an Mháistreás, ar an chúntóir ranga, ar an seomra féin agus ar ár gcairde nua uilig sa Náiscoil. ## Eolas Náiscoile / Náiscoil Information

- ❖ Teacht ar scoil: Osclaíonn doirse Náiscoile ar 8.55r.n. Glac do pháiste isteach chuig an seomra ranga le do thoil agus fág le ball foirne iad. Mar gheall ar chúiseanna a bhaineann le cosaint páiste agus le sláinte agus sábháilteacht, níor chóir ach don fhoireann an doras a oscailt fá choinne daoine atá ag teacht chuig an náiscoil.
- Arrival at school: Náiscoil doors open at 8.55am. Please bring your child into the classroom and leave them with a member of staff. Due to child protection and health and safety reasons, only staff should open the door for people who are arriving at the nursery.

- ❖ Éide scoile: Cinntigh go bhfuil ainm do pháiste scríofa ar a ngeansaí agus ar a gcuid éadaí eile. Cuimhnigh athrú iomlán (sean) éadaigh, cóta fearthainne, buataisí rubair agus bosca ciarsúir amháin a thabhairt isteach don bhliain (ainm do pháiste scríofa ar achan rud).
- School Uniform: Please ensure that your child's name is written on their jumper and other clothing items. Remember to bring in a complete change of (old) clothes, a raincoat, Wellington boots and one box of tissues for the year (your child's name written on everything).
- ❖ Sos: Iarraimid ar thuismitheoirí £1.50 a thabhairt isteach achan Luan (ag tosach ar dara seachtain do phaiste) chun costais sosa, breithlaethanta, cóisirí, comhábhair cócaireachta agus marla, áiseanna breise a chlúdach agus i dtreo costais turas. Tá an Náiscoil ag glacadh páirte sa "Happy Smiles Programme." Is clár bia sláintiúil é seo, mar sin, cuirfimid sos ar fáil do gach páiste agus ní gá dóibh sos a thabhairt isteach ar scoil leo.
- Break: We ask parents to contribute £1.50 each Monday (starting on your child's second week) to cover costs of breaks, birthdays, parties, cooking and dough ingredients, additional resources and towards costs of trips. The Náiscoil is taking part in the "Happy Smiles Programme." This is a healthy eating programme, therefore, we will provide break for all children and they do not need to bring a break into school with them.



- ❖ Caithfear clúdaigh airgid scoile a úsáid chun airgead dinnéir/sosa a íoc-airgead ceart amháin le do thoil & ainm páiste scríofa air. £2 an costas atá ar leabhar clúdaigh don bhliain iomlán agus tá siad ar fáil ón Naíscoil.
  - **School money envelopes must be used to pay dinner/break money- correct money only please & child's name written on. A book of envelopes for the full year costs £2 and they are available from the Naíscoil.**
  - ❖ **Obair na bpáistí:** Deán seic ar phóca do pháiste ar bhonn laethúil fá choinne pictiúir agus litreacha scoile. Cuimhnigh chun moladh agus spreagadh a thabhairt do do pháiste- d'obair siad go crua chun an obair seo a dhéanamh!
  - **Children's work: Please check your child's pocket on a daily basis for pictures and school letters. Remember to praise and encourage your child- they worked hard to do this work!**
  - ❖ **Dóigheanna le cuidiú le do pháiste:** Labhair le do pháiste faoina lá sa naíscoil. Neartaigh téamaí na naíscoile. Pléigh rialacha naíscoile le do pháiste. Léigh scéalta agus dánta le do pháiste. Abair rímeanna agus amhráin. Mol do pháiste as a n-obair. Cuidigh le do pháiste páirt a ghlacadh i dtaispeántais suime nó dathanna trí rud a ghlacadh isteach ón bhaile.
  - **Ways to help your child: Talk to your child about their day in nursery. Reinforce the nursery themes. Discuss nursery rules with your child. Read stories and poems to your child. Recite rhymes and songs. Praise your child for their work. Help your child to participate in any interest or colour displays by bringing something in from home.**
  - ❖ **Marla:** Tá cóip den oideas marla ar fáil. Baineann páistí sult as marla a dhéanamh agus bíonn luach teiripeach bainteach le súgradh marla.
  - **Dough: A copy of the dough recipe is available. Children enjoy making dough and there is a therapeutic value associated with dough play.**
  - ❖ **Breithlaethanta:** Sa dóigh go mothaíonn gach páiste speisialta ar a b(h)reithlá, bíonn cáca againn dó/di. Tugtar é seo amach le linn cóisir do pháiste ar a b(h)reithlá nó ar an lá is cóngaraí dó. Mar sin, ní gá duit cáca, bunnóga nó milseáin a thabhairt isteach agus cinntíonn seo go bhfaigheann gach páiste an rud céanna ar a mbreithlá.
  - **Birthdays: So that each child feels special on his/her birthday, we have a cake for him/her. This is distributed during your child's party on their birthday or the nearest day to it. Therefore, you do not need to send cakes, buns or sweets in and this ensures that all children get the same thing on their birthday.**
